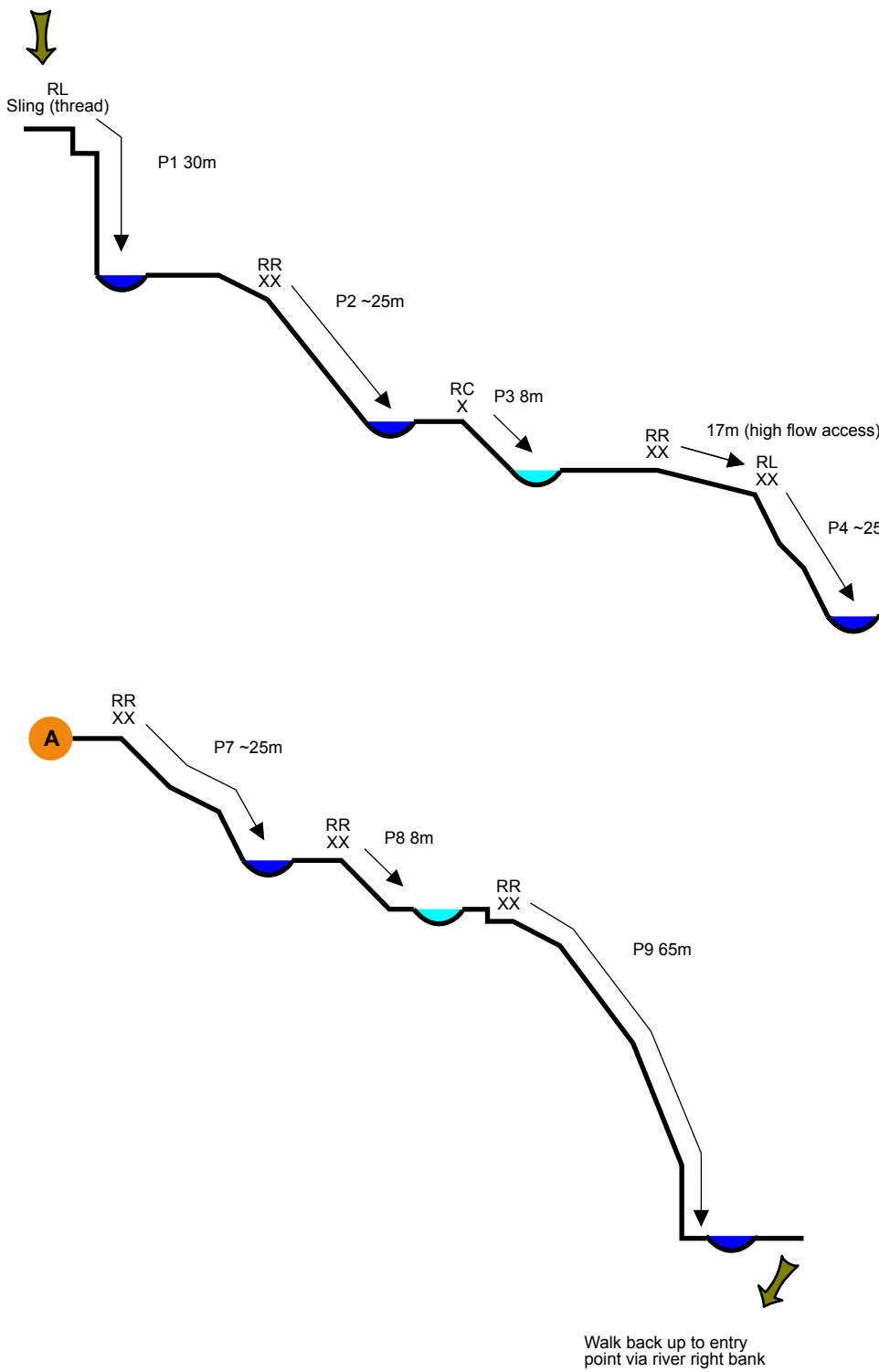



Box Creek v4a2II\*  
Kanangra-Boyd National Park









Box Creek is a sequential series of open granite sloping slab waterfalls. Exit is possible from almost every Problem.

P9 can be completed using 60m rope if extended by 5m from anchor. Leave rope in place and collect on way back up.

-  Creek walking, rock hopping, boulder scrambling
-  Entry/exit with direction
-  Topo continues at same lettered circle
-  Shallow pool (wading)
-  Deep pool (swimming)
-  Abseil/Rapel
-  Abseil/Rapel in flow

-  Tree
-  Caution, notes a specific dangerous feature
